



Program Guide

1. Novice:

This class is designed for individuals who have little to no fencing experience.

The introductory course is two classes, once per week, 85 minutes each class. This class is taught by Master Instructors or advanced/formally trained fencers. All equipment and materials are provided by the Academy.

Open to non – IFA members.

2 x 85 minute classes, once a week

Tuition fee is \$99.00 for the entire course

2. Beginner:

This class is for IFA members who have taken an introductory course or have some basic knowledge of fencing. This class is twice a week, 55 minutes each class. Private lessons are recommended for this level. This is a non competitive level. Member needs to purchase basic equipment (mask (electrical for Saber), glove, under arm protector, chest protector, and a jacket).

2 x 55 minute classes per week

Tuition fee is \$150.00/month

3. Intermediate (Promotion to this class is after consultation with the coach):

This class is for IFA members who compete in **local** tournaments. This class meets twice a week, 85 minutes each class, with an additional third class of open fencing time. At this level, the fencer should be receiving one private lesson a week. Electrical equipment needed (body cord, weapon, knickers, and a lame for Foil and Saber). Coaching at some local tournaments included in monthly tuition fee (at discretion of coach). Team warm-ups are recommended.

2 x 85 minute classes plus one open fencing session per week

Tuition fee is \$199.00/month

4. Advanced (Promotion to this class is after consultation with the coach) :

This class is for IFA members who compete in **local and national** tournaments. This class meets three times a week, 85 minutes each class with and addition two class of open fencing time. At this advanced level, fencer should be receiving two or more private lessons a week. Full electrical equipment needed (at least 2 body cords, 2 weapons, along with the full fencing equipment). Coaching provided at local tournaments same as Intermediate level. Coaches' fees and travel expenses for national tournaments are not included in the monthly tuition fees.

3 x 85 minute classes plus 2 open fencing sessions per week

Tuition fee is \$249.00/month

5. Fitness & Recreation:

Looking for a fun way to exercise? Not yet at competitive level but need more of a challenge? Then, this class is best for you. This class meets twice a week, 85 minutes each class, with an additional third class of open fencing time. Member needs to purchase or own basic equipment (weapon, body cord, mask (electrical for Saber), glove, under arm protector, chest protector, and a jacket).

2x 85 minute classes plus one open fencing session per week

Tuition fee is \$175.00/month

6. Private lessons: 20-25 minutes individual one-on-one lesson with a Master Instructor.

1 lesson is \$35.00
